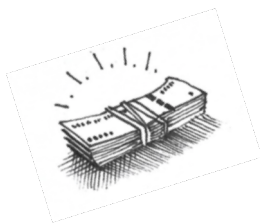

DIRECTIONS

To Kipling Lodge

ROUTE 1 Favourite

Traveling via **GAYAZA** Road and arriving by the **NORTH**:

Before reaching Kayunga, you should follow the direction of Njeru and travel for approx. 25km. Turn left at the signpost after the village of **NAKIRUBI** to join the road to Kipling as indicated on the map.

ROUTE 2

Traveling via **JINJA** Highway arriving by the **SOUTH**:

Coming from Kampala, before reaching Jinja, you should take the direction of Kayunga and travel approx. 22km. Turn right at the signpost after the village of **BUKEEKA**, as indicated on the map.
